- <u>Annexation</u>

- Fire/EMS Agreement
 - Mr. Salmon stated that Steve McHugh, Council for the City of Oxford and Roger Gates, Butler County Prosecuting Attorney Office representing the Township had discussed the proposed Fire/EMS agreement. Mr. Salmon stated that he received the proposed agreement from Mr. McHugh and indicated that Mr. Gates hadn't reviewed the proposed changes.
